To be given consideration in this phase of the investigation, all such information must be received by January 14, 2001.

Any information submitted to the Commission by interested parties concerning this investigation is deemed to be public information unless clearly marked confidential. Where the submission by an interested party is confidential, a non-confidential version of the submission must also be provided which will be disclosed to other interested parties upon request.
